THE HANDICAP SYSTEM

The Handicap System was introduced in 1987 and is based on the CB's overall improvement from the previous championships.

Based on the National State Championship Table of both the current and previous year, CB's are given a handicap points start using the results obtained from both championships, and aggregating into a final score.

New Divisions competing in the current year are excluded from the formula as no start can be given for past years results.

States not competing in a division in the current year will have no points included in "previous Years" tally so as to keep the scores more accurate.

States having teams entered in the "current year" without "previous year" participation, will have a maximum 15 points added to their total to receive a start for the current year.
