INTERNATIONAL RESULTS





This document traces the History of Touch Football in Niue and the results it has achieved at F.I.T. sanctioned events. Whilst playing international touch games at other endorsed F.I.T events, some records are sketchy or were not kept and do not form part of the official History for Niue.

Tasman Utatao set the wheels in motion for Niue to become the ninth member of the Federation of international Touch on the 5th December 1991. He organised three teams to attend the second World Cup in Auckland thus beginning the international Touch career of the tiny island nation.

They attended the inaugural South Pacific Island nations Tournament in 1998 which was the forerunner to the South Pacific Champions where they have attended each event up until the last championship in 2009.

Tasman turned the reigns over to Stanley Kalauni and World Cup events have been regularly attended with Niue finishing third in 1995 in both Open and Senior divisions and again third at the World Masters in 1997. Stanley Kalauni the Niue Touch President then passed the baton to the Niue Touch Sports Tour Director- Rhonda Tohovaka – Togipau from 2009 where she continued to lead the Niue Touch Sports teams to a number of international events.

Niue has performed exceptionally well over the years with the small nation overcoming a number of hurdles to take part in World Cup Touch events around the World with the support of FIT and Rhonda's passion and commitment to ensure there is representation from Niue. Niue Touch participated at the South Pacific Mini Games hosted by the Cook Islands in 2009, the Open Women's were bronze medallists at this event and the Open Men's and Mixed teams placed fourth. They also were Bronze Medallist at the Youth World Championships in 2001.

The commitment from Niue Touch to take part in the Touch World Cup 2011 event hosted in Scotland was a significant achievement and the 40s Men's were bronze medallists and the Open Mixed team placed sixth. Niue Touch also took part in the 2015 World Cup campaign and had representation from 4 teams, Open and Masters mixed, 40's and 50's Men's which was hosted by Touch Australia in Coffs Harbour.

The opportunity to show case the pride and passion of our beloved Niue, also affectionately known as 'The Rock' Of Polynesia on the touch fields, to represent our families, and play touch at a competitive international level is our privilege.
