Enrique Garcia-Rey set the ball rolling for the formation of Touch in Chile in October 1996 when he approached the Federation about forming a National association. For Many years a Womens Touch Competition was run by Mike Harrison and Regina Molloy from the Santiago Touch Rugby Club and within a few years the sport had grown significantly within the region.

It wasn't until March 2002 when Chris MacGuire and Isidora Brieba contacted FIT to advise them that with a hard working group of touch fanatics the current season of the Santiago Touch Rugby League was underway and that maybe one day they could aspire to get a team together to go to the World Cup.

In September 2006 Victor Masjuan, Secretary of the Touch Rugby Club of Santiago, Chile contacted the Federation and advised *" I am proud to say that this year we have managed to become accredited under Chilean Law as an official sports club and we have a strong interest in joining the FIT "*

The culmination of all these people's effort came to fruition in 2015 when the first Challain team arrived in Australia to compete in the World Cup in the Mixed Division where they finished ahead of two nations who had been exposed to International Touch form many years. A very creditable effort.
