# INTERNATIONAL RESULTS



This document traces the History of Maori Touch's participation at International sanction Federation Tournaments.

The National Māori Touch Trust was established at an inaugural meeting through mandate from lwi (tribal), hapu (sub tribal), waka (ancestral canoe) and takiwa (regional boundary) representation from throughout Aotearoa.

Trusts outcomes include, Holding an annual Māori Touch NZ National Touch Tournament, Selecting national teams to represent Māori Touch NZ at international competition, Support the development of Māori touch organisations that represent iwi, hapu, waka and takiwa throughout Aotearoa and Support the participation and development of Māori in the sport of touch.

FIT held the inaugural Youth World Cup in 2001 in Auckland. The Maori Touch organisation had tried to enter the tournament prior to the event and were denied as they were not a Federation Member. Death threats against the then FIT executive and a promised campaign to disrupt the tournament forced the organisers to relent and allow their team to play.

Maori Touch again appeared in 2005 at the New Zealand Touch organised International All Nations Tournament being represented in Mens, Women and Mixed Seniors events.
